

Internal regulations for dogs:

With the present, Mr./Mrs.: is responsible for the dog or dogs on his plot and guarantee that::

- 1. His dog has an assurance and a health file.
- 2. That the dog would not walk alone around the campsite, that is, outside from his plot.
- 3. That the dog would never get into the toilettes or the pool.
- 4. Is responsible of dog's continuous hygiene in order to avoid parasites.
- 5. That the dog won't relieve itself in the Campsite. And that it is important to pick up all dog faeces when they are deposited outside of established areas (outside from the Camping, we have a place where dogs can be free, always under a responsible supervision).
- 6. For the safety of people, other animals and your dog, it is necessary to have it tied in the whole Camping.
- 7. Dogs potentially dangerous: Those are dogs regulated with specific rules, as a special license for the owner, that qualify him to have it and others like muzzle use and tie no longer than 2 metres in public spaces. Potentially dangerous types are: Pit Bull Terrier Stafford shire Bull Terrier American Stafford shire terrier Rottweiler Dogo argentino Fila Brasilero Tosa Inu-Akita Inu. The owner is responsible of the use of muzzle and a tie no longer than 2 metres in the whole Campsite.

The non-fulfillment of anyone of this rules, would be reason enough for the Campsite Direction to expel the family owner of the dog.
